About the project

ScoopConSS started in 1st March 2020 and will end in December 2022.

The project aims to create a community of practice for European secondary school teachers interested in improving their teaching practice using different business methods based on cooperative principles of self-help, self-responsibility, democracy, equality, equity and solidarity. The specific objective of the project is the promotion and acquisition, by teachers, of professional teaching tools and methods, with the objective of facilitating the development of entrepreneurial skills for school students.

Project Goals:

- **Analyse** data and information of successful practices in youth entrepreneurship training and education schemes.
- **Improve and develop** guidelines and tools (a toolkit) which will be made available to the selected teachers/trainers for piloting within their educational context .
- **Develop** a teachers' curriculum and training methodology, which will take into consideration the output of the results of the interviews to VET teachers and responsible of social cooperatives conducted in partner countries.
- **Disseminate project results** to policy makers, practitioners and other stakeholders to increase awareness for entrepreneurial education.


Project Objectives:

The **main objective** of the SCoopConSS project is to build a Community of Practice for European secondary school teachers interested in boosting their teaching practice by using different entrepreneurial methods based on the cooperative principles of self-help, self-responsibility, democracy, equality, equity and solidarity.

The **specific objective** of the project is to promote the acquisition of professional teaching tools and methods for teachers, aimed at facilitating the development of entrepreneurial skills for VET students.

In a **long-term perspective**, we aim at increasing the number of teachers who will benefit from the teaching methodologies and tools contained in the project's toolkit, making teachers themselves become ambassadors of the initiative in their school context, in order to allow entrepreneurial education to spread among the education institutions at local and national level.

Project Outcomes:

- better understanding of existing trainings tools on teaching entrepreneurship.
 - adaptation of the existing curricula to create specific tools for social business teaching.
 - implementation of a blended-training course on cooperative business.
 - teaching tools experimentation and students mentoring.
