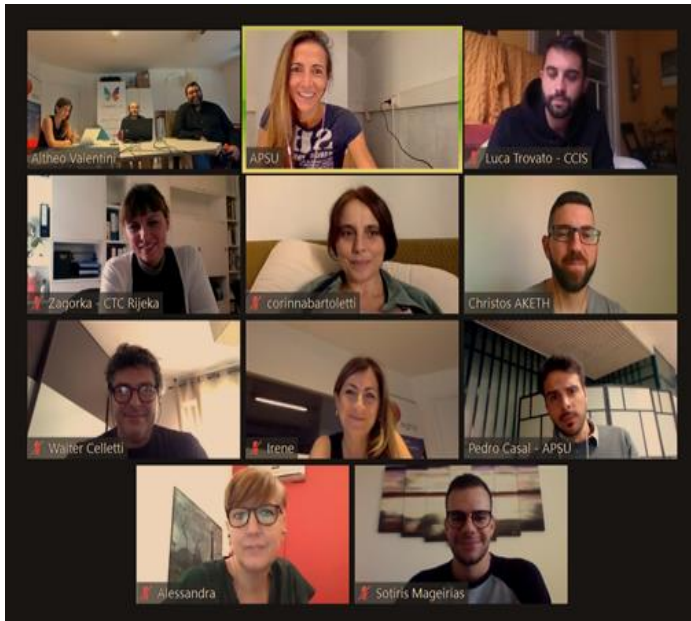

Kick Off Meeting (September 2020)



The ScoopConSS team Kick Off Meeting (KOM) took place on the 23rd and 24th September 2020 via Skype due to COVID 19 restrictions. Partners have assessed the project's status, and the main conclusions were the Blended Training Course and the Toolkit to be developed, both designed for improving teachers' cooperative teaching skills. Besides those topics, the further steps to be given in the project, namely the workshops and the piloting programme, were also discussed. Partners were happy about the progress made and are thrilled with the upcoming challenges.

Conclusions of the training needs analysis report (October 2020)

In the last months, the ScoopConSS team has interviewed a set of teachers and other staff linked to the Education and Social Entrepreneurship sectors, with the main aim of measuring how widely the entrepreneurship education is spread in the partnership countries. For the purposes of gathering relevant information, it was planned to implement series of coaching circles with teachers and managers of social cooperatives. The main conclusion of the report state that there are emerging problems at national level from the point of view of methods, techniques and work strategies related to social entrepreneurship, thus, greater investment is needed to support the teaching of this topic. Proposed training path for teachers (October 2020)

The Consortium started to prepare the ScoopConSS Curriculum for Teachers, which should be produced with the goal of building a Community of Practice for European Secondary School teachers interested in boosting their teaching practice by using different entrepreneurial methods based on the cooperative principles of self-help, self-responsibility, democracy, equality, equity and solidarity. For this purpose, SCoopConSS aims at developing, piloting and reviewing a blended training course to support teachers of VET Institutions in mentoring their students for the participation at the first edition of the EU Scoop! Contest, a Social Cooperative Simulation Contest to be scaled-up at EU level.





The training programme addressed to teachers from partner countries consists of:

- Piloting and validation of the ScoopConSS Curriculum and Toolkit
- National and transnational workshops
- Job-shadowing activities
- Mentoring students for the EU Scoop! Contest

In the upcoming months, the Partnership will be ready to publish the entire report and teachers will be able to join the Community of Practice and start the online training using our Moodle platform!
